Meet Links and Room Information

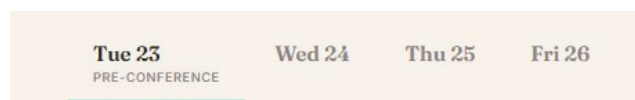
At the top of the programme, you will see several **Meet Links** and three building icons with room numbers.

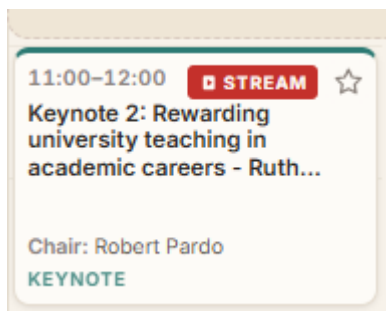

The following events will be professionally streamed:

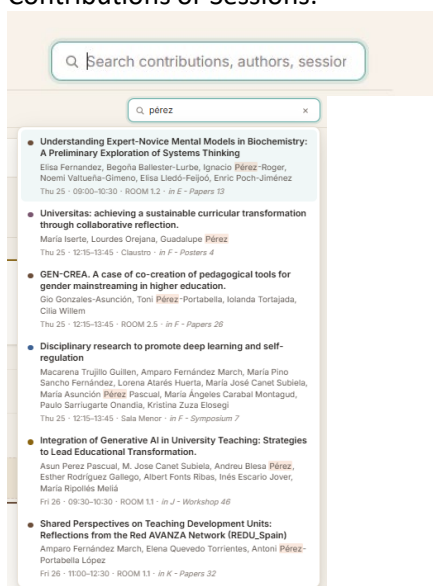
- Keynotes

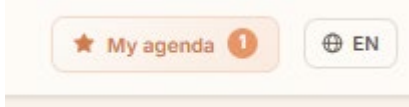
Use the **Search** button at the top of the programme to quickly find Authors, Presenters, Contributions or Sessions:
